

# Lifting of Prohibition on Exports to the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia including Kosovo

I&E Notice No. 6/2001

8 Oct 2001

To: All Traders, Freight Forwarders,  
Cargo Agents and Carriers

Further to our I&E Notice No. 7/98 dated 13 Apr 1998, we wish to inform you that the prohibition of the following exports to the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, including Kosovo, from Singapore is lifted with immediate effect:

- a. arms and related materials of all types, including
  - i) weapons
  - ii) ammunition
  - iii) military vehicles and equipment
  - iv) paramilitary equipment; and
- b) spare parts for the items listed in (a).
