**LIFTING OF MARKINGS ON CIGARETTES FOR  
EXPORT AND RE-EXPORT**



Currently, all exports and re-exports of Marlboro, Salem, Dunhill, Kent and Gudang Garam cigarettes to Bangladesh, Cambodia, East Timor, Indonesia, Laos, Myanmar, Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam are required to be embossed with 'E' or 'Singapore Duty Not Paid' markings on every packet and outer carton. With effect from 1 Apr 2003, this requirement for marking will be lifted.

2 For duty exempted tobacco products, including cigarettes, that are supplied to Embassies and High Commissions, the marking requirement of "Duty Exempted for Diplomatic/Consular Use" or "DC" in short, on every packet and outer carton will remain status quo.

3 This circular supersedes the previous Customs Circular No. 23/2000 dated 24 Jun 2000.
