BRIEFING ON CHANGES TO TRADENET® DECLARATION PROCESS FOR COMPLEMENTARY HEALTH PRODUCTS (CHP) FROM 1 JUNE 2014

We would like to invite importers, freight forwarders and declaring agents of Complementary Health Products (CHP) to a briefing session on changes to the TradeNet® declaration process for the following categories of health products from 1 June 2104.

- a. Chinese Proprietary Medicines (CPM)
- b. Traditional Medicines
- c. Homoeopathic Medicines
- d. Health Supplements
- e. Traditional medicinal materials
- f. Medicated oil and balm, medicated plasters
- g. Medicated beverages

Main Process Changes

2 The main changes that we will be sharing at the briefing sessions include the following:

- The Health Products Regulation Group (HPRG), HSA will set up a new Competent Authority (CA) specifically for processing import declarations of CHP.
- While there will not be any changes to the HS Codes, a new set of Product Codes will be introduced for import declarations of CHP.
